Program Development (process)

- Feb.2008: Ministerial Declaration of Libreville & roadmap
- Nov. 2008: Approval of the Program by the GEF Council
- 2009: Project concept Development
- 2010/2011: Project Development (# 23.3 months)



Rationale for the Program

- O project situation at mid-GEF4
- Recurrent difficulties to raise funds (RAF, cofinancing)
- Tropical Forest Account



Key figures for the CBSP

- GEF: \$50 million (Allocations + Tropical Forest Account)
- Cofinancing: \$200 million
- 13 projects: 5 regional, 1 transboundary, 7 national
- \$812,000 \$13 million (# \$3.7m)

3 main orientations

- Conservation of ecosystem functions and values within the regional protected area network,
- Fostering of sustainable management and use of forest and water resources in the productive landscape of the Congo Basin,
- Strengthening the policy, regulatory, institutional and sustainable financing framework for sustainable ecosystem management

Conservation of Biodiversity Hotpsots

- Congo DR, WB, CBSP Forest and Nature Conservation Project, GEF \$6 million, cofinancing 62 million
- Equatorial Guinea, UNDP, GEF 1,7 million, cofinancing \$4,450 million
