Implementation of Germany's fast start commitment (in million euros)

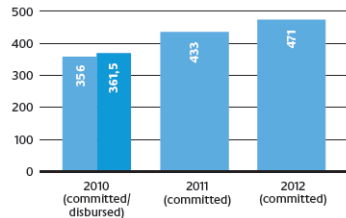


Fig. 1: Germany's contribution to fast start financing

ICI – Achievements

- 2008 until November 2011: Funding 250 projects in over 80 partner countries with total amount of € 556 million (US \$ 751 million)
- Mobilising of additional capital (implementing agencies + other public and private-sector sources): € 797 million
- **€ 1.35 billion** total volume of ICI projects

- Adaptation: 42 projects (€ 72 million), another 15 projects (€ 50 million) pending
- **€ 122 million for adaptation**
+ EbA Programme: € 10 million

EbA Flagship Programme

- Launched in Cancún 2010
- Partnership approach between UNEP, UNDP and IUCN

- Implemented in Uganda, Nepal and Peru
- Focus on mountain ecosystems with selected sites:
 - Mt. Elgon (Uganda)
 - Harpankhola Watershed (Nepal)
 - Nor Yauyos-Cochas (Peru)
