Ecosystems in the UNFCCC



"The ultimate objective of this Convention ... is to achieve... stabilization of greenhouse gas concentrations in the atmosphere ... should be achieved within a time frame sufficient to **allow** ecosystems to adapt naturally to climate change."

"Invites all Parties to enhance action on adaptation under the Cancun Adaptation Framework, [...] by undertaking, inter alia, the following: (d) Building resilience of socioeconomic and ecological systems, including through economic diversification and sustainable management of natural resources."

Ecosystem-based approaches to adaptation under the CBD



Ecosystem-based approaches for adaptation:

- •ecosystems can be managed to limit climate change impacts on biodiversity and to help people adapt
- •sustainable management, conservation and restoration of ecosystems, as part of an overall adaptation strategy

Integrating ecosystem-based approaches to adaptation in National Policy

- Development plans and strategies
- Climate change policies
- Adaptation plans, incl. NAPAs, NAPs
- Sectoral policies, especially in natural resource management (e.g. forest, water, agriculture)
- Environmental Policies
- UNCCD NAPs and NBSAPs
- Disaster Management Plans

Integrated in climate change and development policies

- Review: 1 out of 18 policies in Peru; 7 out of 17 policies in Nepal; 5 out of 16 policies in Uganda
- Critical components of climate change policy in all countries
- Seen as part of broader development, economic growth and poverty reduction in National Development Plans


Not included in other National Policies

- **Sectoral policies** (e.g. Agriculture, Forests, Conservation, Water)
- Environmental policies
- Disaster strategies
- NBSAPS, UNCCD NAPs
- Many of these policies are outdated and formulated before climate change was included in policy planning
- Cross-sectoral approaches needed

Prioritised in National adaptation programmes and plans

- In Nepal, 4 out of 9
 NAPA priority projects
- In Uganda, 6 out of the 9 NAPA priority projects
- Peru National Action Plan, 12 out of 21 projects of national priority





Implementing ecosystem-based approaches to adaptation

- Integrated approaches
- Combined with other approaches to adaptation e.g. hard infrastructure
- Further research is required, incl. VIAs
- Actions are already being implemented on the ground
