Transport to the Pavilion:

The bus shuttle stop is at the exit of the Accreditation Pavilion (Pavilion #1, the only entry/access point to RioCentro). The shuttle is a black bus from MAN (Volkswagen). There is a sign on the window which reads 'Riocentro, Parco Atletico and Autodromo'. This shuttle takes between 10 -20 minutes. If in doubt, please ask volunteers who will point you to the stop. Another option is taking the public bus 613 outside on the street. Upon entry to the Athlete's Park (note the separate entrance for those accredited to the Rio+20 conference), you will see a large map – the Rio Conventions Pavilion is located close to Pavilion A, walk to the right side of the Park.
